ALLISON BURGWIN and JEFF CRAGGS, Snohomish Senior Center members, live in Granite Falls and have been performing together for almost 44 years. They met and married in San Antonio, Texas in 1965. Allison owned a private dancing school there and choreographed dance concerts for the San Antonio Symphony. She studied Dance at the Julliard School of Music in New York City under the guidance of such dance greats as: Jose Limon, Martha Graham and Anthony Tudor.

Jeff studied Broadcasting and Theatre at WSU, graduating in 1964. He got his professional start as a member of the resident company of the Seattle Repertory Theatre in 1967. In 1972 the couple moved to Tucson and the University of Arizona, where Jeff taught in the Drama Department. In 1974 they traveled to Columbia Missouri and Stephens College where Allison finished her BA in Dance and taught at the University of Missouri while Jeff was an actor/teacher/director at Stephens.

They finally settled in Snohomish County. In 1979 Allison started the Moving Company Dance Workshop in Everett. There she taught ballet and choreographed dance concerts for her students and with the Everett Symphony. Meanwhile, Jeff involved himself in the business of the family farm in Granite Falls and became manager/owner of the farm from 1985 until 2003. *Rosie and Harry In Love* is a romantic comedy which examines the always interesting problems that arise when a man and woman get together.
